



# Instructions to Authors: International Journal of Play Therapy®

## Submission

The Association for Play Therapy (APT) contracts the American Psychological Association (APA) to market, technically edit, publish, and distribute its semi-annual, peer-reviewed *International Journal of Play Therapy*®. Authors are invited to review these instructions and then click on and submit their manuscripts thru the following online portal:

Submit manuscripts electronically (.rtf or .doc) through the Manuscript Submission Portal.

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Authors must categorize their submissions as one of the following options:

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- *Current Practices.* Articles regarding beneficial play therapy practices, current issues, and concerns related to play therapy that include theoretical underpinnings for practices and/or issues. Manuscripts, including references, must not exceed 20 pages.

The *Journal* publishes and disseminates reports of original research, theoretical articles, and substantive reviews of topics germane to play therapy on behalf of psychologists, psychiatrists, social workers, counselors, school counselors, marriage and family therapists, and other mental health professionals.

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Authors should prepare manuscripts according to the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (6th ed.)*. Manuscripts may be copyedited for bias-free language (see chapter 2 of the *Publication Manual*). Formatting instructions (all copy must be double-spaced) and instructions on the preparation of tables, figures, references, metrics, and abstracts appear in the *Manual*. See APA's Checklist for Manuscript Submission.

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- A minimum of 5 references from peer-reviewed publications/journals, that are no older than 5 years
- Submit 3-4 learning objectives written in behavioral learning terms
- 10 exam questions

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
