CRNA's will utilize the processes of assessment, diagnosis, management, and evaluation to provide care that integrates the psychosocial and physical needs of the patient and their family.

- Master's degree or higher from a nurse anesthesia educational program accredited by the Council on Accreditation of Nurse Anesthesia Educational Programs (COA).
- Valid State of Texas RN License.
- Valid State of Texas CRNA License.
- National Certification Examination required by the National Board of Certification and Recertification for Nurse Anesthetists (NBCRNA).
- U.S. Citizenship or Employment Authorization to work in the U.S.
