In mid-December 2016, the Commission on Language Learning of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences (AAAS), released its data report on the state of language learning in the United States. Made up of nationally recognized leaders in education, research, business, and government, the Commission gathered leading research on language learning from scholarly and professional organizations. Their initial release covers statistical data on language acquisition in the United States with respect to primary education, secondary education, post-secondary education, and U.S. Census data.
