Manuscript Checklist

All authors should assure this checklist is strictly followed when submitting manuscripts to the *Journal*:

- Pages are numbered
- Double-spaced
- Authors' first name, middle initials, and last name are included
- Authors' degrees are included
- Authors' affiliations are included
- Running head (i.e., a short title consisting of less than 40 characters)
- Abstract
- Key words: six to eight words for use in indexing
- Proper format per article type (i.e., Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions, etc.)
- Acknowledgments, if needed
- References
 - Identified in text by superscript numeral
 - Cited in numerical order
 - In appropriate style as outlined in our "Instructions to Authors"
 - All references cited in text are included in the References section
 - Citations in the References section are used in the text
- Table titles/captions are self-explanatory
- Figures (uploaded in separate files; 1 figure per file)
 - Photographs are of high contrast and high quality (300 dpi is preferred)
 - Salient features are identified by a letter label
 - Legends/captions are self-explanatory (should appear in article file; NOT figure file)
- Products are cited in text
 - Generic names used in text
 - Commercial name with city, state, country in parentheses
- Genus and species of all animals other than domestic animals are used
- Units of weight, length, and temperature are in metric units
