\*An athlete can only acquire one (1) athlete quota place at any Pan Am Qualification competition for its NOC regardless of how many places or boats that athlete tries to qualify

\*An athlete can only compete in one (1) event in Canoe Slalom at the Pan American Games. In the case where an NOC has not qualified a quota place in an event, in this case only, an athlete may compete in more than one (1) event. An athlete may compete in a maximum of two (2) events in Canoe Slalom

\*Athletes qualified in Canoe Slalom will also be qualified in Extreme Canoe Slalom

\*Athletes who qualify in the Extreme Canoe Slalom competition may compete in a Canoe Slalom event if their National Federation has not qualified in that event.

\*An NOC is allowed to obtain a maximum of one (1) boat per event in the Pan American qualification competition

## Athlete eligibility

Only those athletes who have complied with the Olympic Charter (at all times) may participate in the Pan American Games. For the sake of clarity, all athletes must comply with the provisions of the Olympic Charter in force during the qualification period for the Pan American Games up until the end of the period of the Pan American Games.

An NOC must participate in the events at the 2019 Pan American Championships (Pan Am Games Qualifier) if the NOC wants to become eligible for Athlete Quota positions to compete at the 2019 Pan American Games in Lima, Peru.

Athletes must have signed and submitted the Athlete Eligibility Condition Form.  
The age a competitor can compete is in the year that their 15th birthday falls in.

## Qualification System Canoe Slalom

Athlete qualification quota places will be allocated to the respective NOC and not to the competitor(s) that have achieved the quota place in the qualified event.

The number of Athlete quota places will be as follows:

By the end of the 2019 Pan American Championships (Pan American Games Qualifier) all quota places will have been distributed.

A maximum of three (3) boats per NOC per event may compete in the 2019 Pan American Championships to obtain athlete quota positions for the 2019 Pan American Games.

### Host Country Representation

The Host NOC must compete in the event they wish to qualify, at the 2019 Pan American Championships in order to guarantee their Host Country Athlete Quota for the 2019 Pan American Games.

Should the host NOC not manage to obtain an athlete quota place in the respective events, it will still be entitled to receive quota places in the following events.

The quota places allocated to the Host NOC would be taken from the lowest ranked NOC(s) in the respective events at the 2019 Pan American Championships.

## Qualification System Canoe Extreme Slalom

Athlete qualification quota places will be allocated to the respective NOC and not to the competitor(s) that have achieved the quota place in the qualified event.

The number of Athlete quota places will be as follows:

## Athletes qualified in Canoe Slalom are eligible to compete in Extreme Canoe Slalom

A maximum of three (3) boats per NOC per event may compete in the 2019 Pan American Championships (Pan American Games Qualifier) to obtain athlete quota positions for the 2019 Pan American Games.

## Confirmation of Quota Places

The CF (COPAC) will confirm to PASO and NOCs the places they have qualified by April 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019. The NOCs will confirm with the CF the places they will use by May 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019.

## Reallocations of Remaining Quotas

In case of no fulfillment of the 34 Athlete quotas in Canoe Slalom, the unused quotas will be obtained by K1W, C1W, K1M and C1M boats, with repetition of this order until all unused quotas are fulfilled or there are no K1W, K1M or C1M boats left to obtain quotas.

In case of no fulfillment of 10 athlete quotas in Extreme Canoe Slalom, the unused quotas will be obtained by K1W, K1M boats with repetition until all unused quotas are fulfilled.

The President of COPAC in coordination with the COPAC Canoe Slalom committee will allocate the remaining quotas to the rest of the NOC's according to their performance by May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019

The placement of unused quotas will follow the order of alternate preference between K1W, C1W, K1M and C1M.

## Tripartite Commission Invitation Places

ONE (1) Tripartite Place will be available in Canoe Slalom. This place will be attributed to a Canoe Slalom athlete. In the order of K1W, C1W

To be eligible for a Tripartite Commission Invitation Place an NOC must have participated in the 2019 Canoe Slalom Pan American Qualification
