The ACNL Executive Leadership Academy (ELA) is a transformational experience designed for nurse leaders desiring to meet the challenges of executive leadership practice. The curriculum aligns with the American Organization of Nurse Executives (AONE) competencies; the California Action Coalition's integrated competencies, based on work by ACNL members in response to the landmark Institute of Medicine's *Future of Nursing Report*; and elements of the *Magnet Model for Nursing*. This 12-month program deepens leadership competencies through modules that coach and educate attendees about:

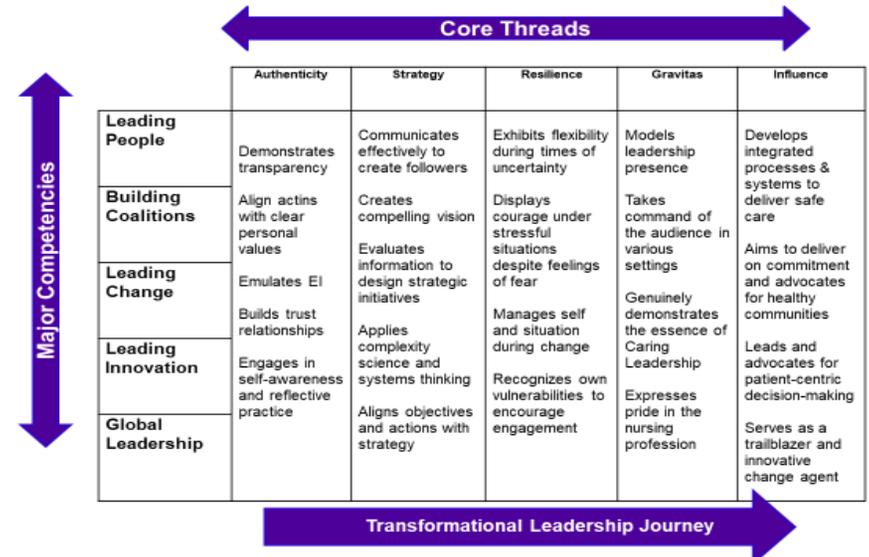
- ✦ **Leading People** through authentic communication and reflective practice skills.

### Program Overview

The ELA includes 28 weeks of didactic and mentorship learning. Five weeks of break time is built into the curriculum. Attendees will come together for learning intensives four times during the program. One of the in-person intensives will coincide with ACNL's Annual Conference. In addition, there will be required readings, recorded lectures, synchronous and asynchronous webinars, and group discussions via discussion boards.

### Application Process and Program Fees

In addition to completing an application, ACNL members will provide two letters of recommendation, submit a personal statement related to their future career path and submit a curriculum vitae. The cost of the program is \$15,000 per attendee which includes the 360-degree assessment and individual learning plan by a certified coach, program materials, and ACNL conference registration during the year of enrollment.
