## URS Building

**10800 Richmond Ave, Houston, TX 77042**

If driving south on the West Sam Houston Tollway, exit Westheimer Ave, and take the feeder road south to Richmond Avenue (2<sup>nd</sup> light after exit). Turn right (west) onto Richmond.

If driving north on the West Sam Houston Tollway, take the Bellaire/Harwin/Westpark Ave (not Tollway!)/Richmond Ave exit (4<sup>th</sup> light after exit), and continue on the feeder road north to Richmond Avenue. Turn left (west) onto Richmond. Or take the Westheimer exit, make a U-turn under the tollway before Westheimer, and travel south to Richmond Ave.
