Subject: Development Services Update on Final Inspections

Dear Development Community Members –

We want to be sure you are aware of the City's update on final inspections. Effective immediately, inspectors will provide final inspections, as allowed under the March 31 [County Public Health Order Section 13\(d\)](#), for all projects where work was ready for a final inspection prior to March 31. Specifically, final inspections will be rescheduled for those that were canceled at the start of the County Order and where construction was completed and confirmed as ready for final inspection. No continuation of construction that is not allowed under the County Order should proceed. Inspectors will wear protective gear, practice social distancing, and will not proceed at any site where conditions appear unsafe. Staff will contact applicants of eligible projects to reschedule.
