

## **“Greatest Hits” Outcrops of the Champlain Valley Belt of West Central Vermont**

This trip will visit some of the most spectacular outcrops in the Champlain Valley for teaching geology to undergraduate students. Not only will we review the original interpretations for each outcrop, but also discuss our recent work with students.

We will go to: the Champlain Thrust at Lone Rock Point, the Hinesburg Thrust at Mechanicsville, the Oven in North Ferrisburgh, Mt. Philo State Park, the Shelburne boat access area, and thrust faults at Shelburne Farms.

You will want to wear hiking shoes or boots. There will be an optional hike to the top of Mount Philo, where you will see spectacular views (1 mile round trip), but if you prefer to stay at the bottom with the bus, there are things to do there as well.
