

On the Cover: The ore dock in Marquette's Lower Harbor. Originally the 6th Dock, called the Duluth, South Shore, and Atlantic Dock, it was constructed in 1931 and closed in 1971 with the simultaneous closing of the Tracy Mine, from which ore shipped from the dock was primarily mined.
