Established in 1989, ALGA's growing membership represents a diverse range of audit offices located primarily in the United States and Canada. Audit members at all levels of the audit organization can participate. Some audit executives are independently elected while others are appointed. The audit organizations serve cities, counties, school districts, and special districts, such as parks, transportation, and water.

ALGA is a recognized industry leader. Association officers and staff help members excel in their financial and performance audits of local government.

Local government auditors from across the country face similar issues and challenges and ALGA provides an avenue for these professionals to meet, communicate and collaborate on important issues and uphold standards of industry best practices.

ALGA's Annual Conference, which is a hybrid event (offered in-person and virtually) is held each May.
