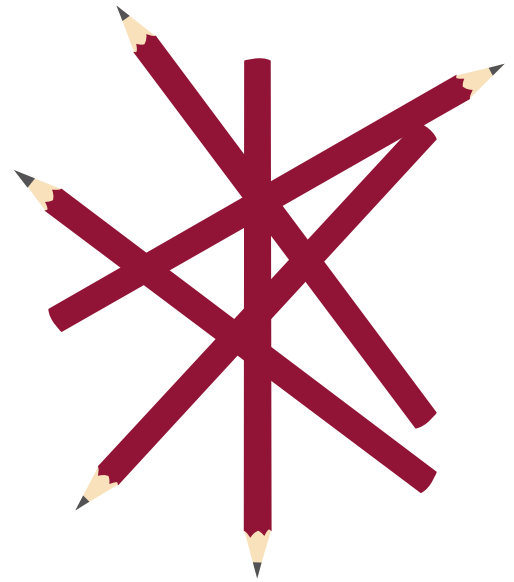


The Lindsay-Crane Center for Writing and Literature at Hiram College Presents
