1. All creative artists (young and old) are invited to submit works. Submissions must be original works created by the artist/writer that reflect an aspect of the Hiram College Field Station property. Genres of creative writing should be limited to 500 words. Entries should be appropriate for all ages and all audiences.
2. Submissions can be dropped off at the Field Station Frohring Lab Building on Wheeler Rd. (Monday through Friday 10:00am-4:00pm) or at the Kennedy Center Help Desk on the Campus of Hiram College on SR. 700. Submissions can also be mailed to Hiram College Friends of the Field Station, Attn: Matt Sorrnick, PO Box 67 Hiram, Ohio 44234.
3. Submissions must include: contributor's name; phone number; address; e-mail; and a brief description of what aspect of the Field Station property is reflected in the work. Two pieces may be submitted per person.
4. Deadline for submissions is November 22, 2013.
5. Creative works will be on display for public viewing at the Frohring Lab Building at the Field Station from December 2, 2013-January 31, 2014.
