Her temporary home has been with the family of Mr. Douglas Burtell with Barb, '65, as her "sister" in the United States.

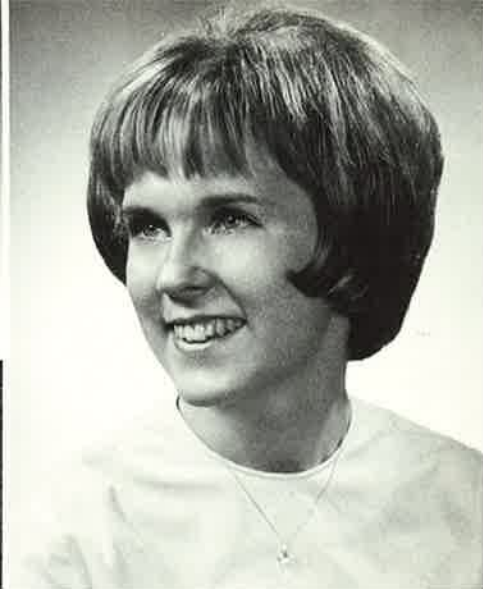
