### *Lincoln University Honorary Degrees*

The Lincoln University Council established an Honorary Degrees Committee in November 1992 to enable it to confer higher doctorates *honoris causa* and to establish guidelines for the award of honorary degrees. The Committee will consider nominations using the criteria below and will make a recommendation to Council regarding the award of honorary degrees.

The degrees available to be awarded are:

D.Com – the degree of Doctor in Commerce

D.Nat.Res – the degree of Doctor of Natural Resources

D.Sc – the degree of Doctor of Science

D.SocSci – the degree of Doctor of Social Science *honoris causa*

### *Award Criteria*

The Nominee will be assessed on the following criteria:

1. The Nominee has achieved very high distinction in his/her field, whether or not that field relates to the fields of specialisation of Lincoln University. That achievement will be considered under the following categories:
  - Agriculture and Natural Resources;
  - Arts, Culture and Sport;
  - Commerce;
  - Environment;
  - Māori;
  - Politics;
  - Recreation and Tourism; and
  - Science and Research.
2. The candidate has established connections with Lincoln University:
  - on account of being a graduate or diplomat of Lincoln University; or
  - on account of being a former member of the Council of Lincoln University; or
  - on account of other connections with Lincoln University; or
  - on account of being a former staff member.

3. The candidate has the potential to enhance the public profile of Lincoln University or of its areas of specialisation or to inspire the students of Lincoln University through being a role model.
