



Advancing Community College Careers:
Education, Scholarship, and Service

Project ACCESS is a professional development initiative for new college mathematics faculty sponsored by the American Mathematical Association of Two-Year Colleges (AMATYC).

Mathematics faculty for whom the upcoming academic year will be their first, second, third, or fourth year of their first full-time renewable position are invited to apply for the next Project ACCESS Cohort.

There is no fee for participation in AMATYC Project ACCESS. It is estimated that the total institutional commitment will be approximately \$2,000 spread over two fiscal years. AMATYC and the AMATYC Foundation will cover some expenses for selected Fellows to attend the AMATYC annual conferences.

Fellows will attend **two consecutive AMATYC annual conferences** where they will participate in specially developed conference workshops as well as regular conference activities.

In the intervening year, Fellows are required to attend an AMATYC Affiliate meeting, an MAA Section meeting or an NCTM Regional meeting near their home institution. As an integral part of their professional development, Fellows are expected to develop, implement, and evaluate a project at their home institution during their Fellowship year.

Project ACCESS has been in existence since 2004. Applications are available March 1st and the deadline to apply is May 15th. Additional details about institutional funding commitments and **application materials** will be available at:
