1. Review of Minutes from April 26, 2018 Conference Call

3. The AMATYC/ASA Joint Committee Report to the ASA

Rob has agreed to represent the AMATYC/ASA Joint Committee at the July 29th Education Council Meeting to be held at JSM in Vancouver.

The group discussed the following 2019 initiatives:

- Propose a themed session for 2019 JSM
- Foster data science at two-year colleges; Assist in data science program development for two-year colleges
- Support/encourage DataFest events at two-year campuses.
- Continue to plan/host webinars, including a webinar addressing statistics education and K-12 teachers

The AMATYC/ASA Joint Committee has been asked to submit a proposal that will be entered in a contest from which a short list of invited sessions for the 2019 JSM will be selected.
