AMATYC has an exciting opportunity for you to be an Evaluator for this year's Student Research League challenge. Last year's Evaluators found this to be rewarding and encouraging as many of the papers were very well written.

The students will submit in mid-April and your evaluations would be due by mid-June. The work requires that you read 5-10 student papers (thesis). You will note if all required parts are included, find one strength and one critique, and indicate if the thesis is Excellent, Strong, or Needs Improvement.

We prefer that each Region has Evaluators to review and select their Regional winners. These students receive recognition and the chance to move forward into the national round of evaluations. The final round will be judged by experts in the fields related to the challenge question who will select the national winners.
