

Jim Linzy Farriers Memorial Clinic Application



In the event that a Regular, Lifetime or Student Member of the association suffers an injury, illness or surgical recovery period that significantly impacts their ability to shoe horses, the fund will provide assistance set forth in Section #1500 of the AFA Policy Manual – Member Services/Membership Committee --The Jim Linzy Farriers Memorial policy in the production of a benefit clinic.

Application must be filled out by the beneficiary's local chapter and submitted to the AFA office. The beneficiary does not necessarily need to be a member of the chapter.

Responsibilities of the host chapter:

1. Establish a clinic fee that all attendees must pay
2. Obtain the facility for the clinic
3. Be responsible for any and all advertisements it feels appropriate
4. Make arrangements for horses if needed
5. Make arrangements for ground transportation for the clinician if necessary
6. Make any lodging arrangements for the clinician
7. Make certain that at least one meal is provided during the clinic
8. Report the results of the clinic to the AFA office, which may use the report to promote the success of the disabled farrier program
9. Give 100% of funds raised by the clinic to the beneficiary at the conclusion of the clinic

Clinician Information:

1. The managers of the fund will maintain a list of available clinicians who meet the criteria set forth in the Jim Linzy Farriers Memorial Fund policy
2. The managers of the fund will work with the host chapter to find a suitable clinician
3. The fund will reimburse the clinician their travel expenses
4. Participating clinicians will donate their time and agree to make no reimbursement demands of the association or the host chapter beyond their travel expenses
5. Assignment preference will be given to Anvil 21 members
6. An alternate list of clinicians who agree to the policy may be developed in order to offset the event that no Anvil 21 clinicians is available
