

**NEW JERSEY 2015 STATE SERVICE PISTOL
AND DISTINGUISHED REVOLVER CHAMPIONSHIPS**

*description of matches is below match bulletin

NRA Registered Outdoor 600 Rimfire Pistol Match, CMP Rimfire EIC Match,
NRA Registered Outdoor 600 Service Pistol Match, CMP Service Pistol EIC Match,
NRA Registered Outdoor 600 Distinguished Revolver Match,
and NRA Distinguished Revolver Match

The results from both locations - for all matches - will be combined.

Match Schedule:

A sighting in period of ten minutes will be conducted before each Championship.

9:00 am - NJ State Rimfire Service Pistol Championship,
followed by a CMP Rimfire EIC Match.

11:30 am - NJ State Service Pistol Championship,
followed by a CMP Service Pistol EIC Match.

2:00 pm - NJ State Distinguished Revolver Championship,
followed by an NRA Distinguished Revolver Match.

Distinguished Revolver and Centerfire Service Pistol competitors may be on the firing line together and fire those Championships and Leg matches in whatever order they choose.

Conditions: The State Service Pistol, Rimfire Service Pistol and Distinguished Revolver Championships are open to New Jersey residents who are individual members of the Association of New Jersey Rifle and Pistol Clubs (ANJRPC). NRA membership is encouraged but not required. Non-residents may enter on a space-available basis, but are not eligible to win State Champion medallion. Eligibility for the either EIC Match is in accordance with CMP rules. CMP Rules will be utilized for the both State Service Pistol Championships and the EIC Matches. NRA rules will govern during the Distinguished Revolver Aggregate and the Distinguished Revolver Match. **USE OF ALCOHOL BEFORE OR DURING MATCH IS FORBIDDEN. "NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OR EMPTY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTAINERS ARE PERMITTED ON THE CLUB PREMISES. VIOLATORS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM COMPETITION AND REQUIRED TO LEAVE THE PREMISES IMMEDIATELY."**

Course of fire for Championship 600s: All slow fire at 50 yards on B-6 targets; timed and rapid fire at 25 yards on B-8 targets. Ranges are equipped with turning targets at 25 yards.

Match #1 - Slow Fire (20 shots)
Match #2 - Timed Fire (20 shots)
Match #3 - Rapid Fire (20 shots)
Match #4 – Aggregate

Course of fire for the CMP Rimfire and Service Pistol Matches, and the Distinguished Revolver Match is the National Match Course.

Awards: (Qualified) winners of 600 Match Aggregates will receive State Championship Medallions from the Association of New Jersey Rifle and Pistol Clubs.

For the Rimfire, Service Pistol and Distinguished Revolver Championships, open awards for each match, open winner not eligible for class awards, class awards as appropriate; after match expenses, 50% of entry fees will be returned to competitors in awards. Awards for the CMP Leg Matches in accordance with CMP Rules. Awards for the Distinguished Revolver Match in accordance with NRA Rules. Scores from the State Service Pistol Championship and the CMP EIC match will be utilized to select members of New Jersey State Service Pistol Team for Camp Perry.

Fees: \$15.00, each, for Rimfire, Service Pistol and Distinguished Revolver Championships. Fee for the Service Pistol Leg Match is \$15.00. If you have not earned any points towards Distinguished, the \$15.00 leg match fee is waived. Fee for Rimfire EIC match is \$10. Juniors pay no entry fees. Fee for the NRA Distinguished Revolver Match is \$2.00. Non-members of CJRPC firing at that location must pay an additional \$5.00 (covers all championship events).

Description of Matches:

The Distinguished Revolver Match is fired with service type revolvers. Competitors who place in the top 10% of the non-distinguished shooters earn ten, eight, or six leg points. A shooter who earns thirty leg points is awarded the Distinguished Revolver badge by the NRA. Firearms used in this match are unmodified revolvers in .38 special with iron sights (see NRA rule 3.1.4). Ammunition is limited to .38 special with 158 grain lead bullets. The course of fire for this match is a thirty round national match course.

Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) Service Pistol leg matches are also held in conjunction with Regional Championships, State Championships, and the National Championships. Competitors fire .45 caliber 1911 or 9mm M9 service pistols with iron sights in this match. Allowable alterations to these pistols are limited and listed in the CMP rule book. Ammunition is restricted to round nose, full metal jacket, ball type ammo. Competitors placing in the top 10% of the non-distinguished shooters competing in the match earn ten, eight, or six leg points. Shooters need to accumulate thirty leg points to be awarded the Distinguished Pistol badge by the CMP. The thirty points accumulated by the shooter must include one eight or ten point leg. Non-distinguished shooters are only eligible to fire four leg matches per year. The course of fire for this match is a thirty shot National Match Course.

Competitors may enter partial matches if space is available at the range. Match sponsors give first preference to shooters who enter the full three-gun 2700, but will allow competitors to enter and only shoot one or two of the 900's if space is available. A new shooter who only has a .22 can enter and only shoot the .22 caliber 900 if space is available.

Most shooters are willing to help new shooters. If you have questions, contact the match sponsor. If you have questions at a match, ask the line officer or range officer. Tell the match sponsor that you are a new shooter when you are entering a match. Usually they will keep an eye on new shooters to answer any questions and ensure you enjoy the event.
