

ROCKIN' THE RUNWAY 2019

STUDENT ENTRY GUIDELINES

Forming the Team:

1. Teams must be made up of at least two student members.
2. Teams must designate one model of their choice, which must meet the model requirements (see below).

Entering a Team for the Event:

1. Complete the student Team application online:
2. Team members, with the exception of the designated model, will need to pay for their admission into the event; general admission ticket price is estimated at \$50/person + cash bar.

The Garment:

1. The theme is "In The Wild". Walkway music should "play" to the theme. How this reference is used is entirely up to the team.
2. Garments must show design creativity and clearly be made of a design material(s).
3. Teams are responsible for transporting their garment to and from the venue.
4. Teams are also responsible for "checkpoints" with the RTR Committee:
 - a. By December 14: Submit description of the garment design concept.
 - b. By January 16: Submit a photo of the garment (finished or in construction phase), name of the model, description and names of team members.
5. Teams will determine how to split the garment construction cost.
6. Note: The following are NOT allowed on Zoo property: balloons, confetti, fog machines/dry ice, silly string, glitter, weapons, fireworks, animal remains, animal replicas, animal images or outside animals. If in doubt about your garment/entry qualifications, check with the RTR Committee.

The Model:

1. Each team model will receive complimentary admission to the event and must be noted on the Team's description.
2. Only one person is allowed to walk the runway.
3. Props are limited to hand-held only.
4. Team Model will need to check-in at Registration the night of the event to be granted admission.
5. Mandatory rehearsal (walk through without garment on) will be on February 7, 2019 at 5:30 pm.
