SB 638	Delivery of Nursing Services	Campbell	Delivery of Nursing Services; Creating the Florida Hospital Patient Protection Act, requiring that each health care facility implement a staffing plan that provides minimum direct care registered nursing staffing levels; prohibiting a health care facility from assigning unlicensed personnel to perform functions or tasks that are performed by a licensed or registered nurse; requiring that certain information be provided to each patient who is admitted to a health care facility; requiring that the agency post on its website information regarding health care facilities on which civil penalties have been imposed, etc. Effective Date: 7/1/2018
