SUBJECT: Hurricane Preparedness for Cranes and Hoisting Equipment
DATE: August 30, 2019

We have heard from Miami-Dade County that there was a concern regarding the safety of cranes in lieu of Hurricane Dorian. As the path of Hurricane Dorian continues to change and strengthen, we are concerned multiple counties throughout the entire state will see potentially hurricane force winds exceed 100 miles per hour.

Therefore, pursuant to my authority as the State Coordinating Officer, granted by Governor DeSantis in Executive Order 19-189, as amended by Executive Order 19-190, I hereby suspend the effect of section 489.113(11), Florida Statutes, for all 67 counties, specifically for hurricane preparedness related to cranes and hoisting equipment, including, but not limited to, tower, mobile and hydraulic cranes. This suspension is effective immediately and expires on Tuesday, September 10, 2019.
