This award is named in honor and memory of Paul Holmes, founder and first legislative advocate for the Community College Facility Coalition (CCFC). One recipient will be honored at the upcoming CCFC Annual Conference.

- Nominees should demonstrate a commitment and dedication to the Mission and Vision of CCFC.

*Mission:* Provide leadership in legislative advocacy to secure and protect funding and deliver critical information, education, and training on facilities issues for community college districts and their business partners to enhance student learning.

*Vision:* Be the voice of knowledge and a resource for California's community college facilities professionals.

- Nominees:
  - May be retired.
  - May be representatives from agencies or outside organizations.
  - Are not required to be a current member of CCFC.
- Nominations will be solicited from the CCFC membership and the CCFC Board of Directors will make the final selection.

- **A brief bio or resume for the nominee**, establishing their background in community college facilities work.
- **One to two paragraphs detailing why this person is being nominated** and what they have done to advance the Mission and Vision of CCFC.
