President's Report Fire Chief Ken McMullen

Greetings CAFC Members and Friends,

Let me begin this Annual Report by thanking the members of the CAFC Board who have, with tremendous collegiality, not only supported the CAFC through the past two years, but also supported me in my bid to continue presiding over the CAFC for the next two years. It is with and through their support that I bring you my report today entitled "Moving in the direction of our intentions".

Movement is good. Last year our annual report was called "wishing we were wrong". We never imagined that the issues we were preparing for would come to bare. We had hoped that our predictions about climate, complexity, availability of personnel, and the size of the asks we were making would not really be need. We didn't know that the 2006 resolution for national fire administration would become so prophetic.

However, we were right and in keeping with the profession, while hoping for the best, we prepared for the worst. We were able to tell the federal government, the public and the media, what must be done. We have known for some time what our system needs, we have been on the record with those needs, and now circumstances, unfortunate as they are, are helping us in the directions of our intentions.

In some cases, like the volunteer firefighter tax credit increase and the firefighter cancer framework, government listened. In other cases, like the fire administration and the explosives regulation, we still have work to do. In still other cases, we're all still trying to grapple with the questions.

Together we have moved the yardstick further than ever before on key issues from firefighter cancer to the tax credit to a national fire administration. Together we are executing our strategic plan. Our policy and advocacy pillar is solid. We need a national fire administration, we need to replenish the stock of equipment, we need to address critical issues from single egress to fireworks, to civilian emergency response capacity, to lithium-

ion batteries, to better coordinating capacity. We can't stop now, and we won't.

Our messaging in service of safety pillar, intended to for the first time to publicly leverage the voice of the fire chiefs through the media, with the public, and with other stakeholder, has positioned CAFC as a national and international presence. If they didn't know who we were, they do now. We need to keep going.

Our programs and services pillar are expanding. We are on the brink of launching the leadership programs that my colleagues Paul Boissonnault and Greg Jones are leading for us. We have new training materials in dangerous goods that are coming your way that my colleagues Ken Uzeloc and Chris Case will be telling you about. We also need to keep going on the Census that Vince MacKenzie and Keven Lefebvre have championed. I can't wait to see the first set of trending data.

We've set all these in motion. We need to keep going. There are too many challenges for us not to rise to the occasion.

Our CAFC for all Pillar is strong and vibrant still anchored by Chief Martens vision to ensure CAFC and the fire service look more like society. We are getting there. We won't stop.

You've all heard us say, 'national associations are what we make of them'. Your presence, involvement, care, and experience allow CAFC to provide advice that is anchored. Let me take this opportunity to again thank various groups and individuals for making this possible.

To the members of the National Advisory Council, your dedication and coordinating capacity is a national treasure. To all who are on committees or chair them, you bring the granularity and focus needed to complex issues and allow us to speak with credibility. To those members who cheer us on from the sidelines, you allow us to say, "we represent". Thank you for being part of this national association. In closing, I'm very excited about the road ahead. We have great challenges, but we also have great opportunity. Thank you.

Answer the Call	Our intentions were to double the volunteer firefighter tax credit. This was completed. The committee led a "Why I
	Answer the Call Campaign" which resulted in 12 volunteers sharing their stories. The videos and photos were
	featured in a calendar that went to all Members of Parliament. We worked with MP Gord Johns to launch a petition
	which was signed by more than 17,000 Canadians in support of the tax credit.
Building Codes	Our intentions were to improve the code change process. Where once the national model code was determined by
	which industry could produce the best lobby, the new codes process came to life this year making the elected
	provincial officials responsible for code change proposals that balance safety, the economy, and the environment.
	We created a codes committee with external stakeholders so we can hash out issues together. Our challenge now
	is to ensure that issues like secondary suites, single egress, are properly addressed. CAFC has a seat on the national
	advisory to the harmonized codes process.
Cancer	Our intentions were to inform CAFC's recommendations to the National Firefighter Cancer Framework. With
	funding from Health Canada, we hosted 6 workshops to feed into the firefighter cancer framework. We'll hear from
	Health Canada in late September what they heard. Our next step is to develop a firefighter cancer "Rapid Response
	Program" to discuss who best to implement firefighter cancer strategies across all departments.
Climate	Our intentions were to inform the recommendations needed to improve the wildfire situation and coordination.
	We have put forward recommendations to the federal government. The next step is to explore and address the use
	of private firefighting companies in wildfire management.
Dangerous	Our intentions were to respond to issues related to dangerous goods. We are hosting the Emergency Response
Goods	Flammable Liquids Incidents Training Curriculum. It has provided representations in response to the review of the
	fireworks regulations. It has renewed its participation on Transport Canada's General Policy Advisory Council.
Equity,	Our intentions are to address bullying in the fire service. We have developed 3 statements based on the literature
Diversity, and	and consensus on what all fire departments need to know, what firefighters need to know, and what incoming
Inclusion	firefighters need to know. Our upcoming women in fire meeting will be cohosted with FSWO, FSWPC, and FSWBC
Executive Chief	Our intentions were to foster the Executive Chief Fire Officer Program. The Council continues to expand the
Fire Officer	Executive Chief Fire Officer Program and the ECFO Aspire candidates. Excitingly this year, we have a record number

Committee	program. The next steps are to make this more broadly available. The Fire Prevention Committee also gave rise to
	the idea that we must get ahead of changing demographics and climate issues. Finally, CAFC participates on the
	National FireSmart Advisory Board.
Governance	Our intentions were to breathe life into the 2006 resolution about a national fire administration. We released a
	report featured in the Hill Time and which became the subject of media interest. We conducted an international
	comparison of models, developed case studies illustrating why Canada needs a national fire Administration. Our
	strategy is to "be water" on "why Canada needs a national fire administration". This is our most important goal
	going forward.
Human Factors	Our intentions were to provide all members with access to the fundamentals of human factors with a view to
Interoperability	improving quality, safety, and experience in the fire service. We released and completed the first course in Human
	Factors from which 60 individuals received certificates.
	Our intentions were to keep ahead of issues in NG911, Public Safety Board Band Network, and make
	representations to the Canadian Standards Association on the future of Intrinsically Safe Radios. We have
	successfully secured an extension to the NG911 deadline.
Leadership	Our intentions were to address a gap in deferred leadership development training as cited in the Great Canadian
	Fire Census 2022 due to budget issues by curating a complimentary course in leadership development and
	currently has a call out for instructors. The course will start in January 2025.
Mental Health	Our intentions were to shift mental health focus to families and first responders. The CAFC Mental Health

CAFC Financial Status and Treasurer's Report

On behalf of the CAFC Board of Directors and the Finance and Audit Committee, it is my pleasure to present the Treasurer's Report for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2023. You can find the audited financial statements on the CAFC website under About Us>Audited Financial Statements and Annual Reports and in your Annual General Meeting packages.

Looking at the statement of financial position, we see that the CAFC has a healthy balance of cash at \$1.403M. Accounts receivable have stayed consistent as have accounts payable and deferred revenue. This indicates that the CAFC has had some predictable expectations and arrangements. Net assets have increased because of the increase in membership, FRC revenues, grants, and contracts.

We see these details more clearly in the statement of income where consistent increases in membership revenues, the return of in person FRC and increased sponsorship and fundraising has assisted CAFC revenues.

On the expense side, CAFC's payroll and conference expenses have increased with all other expenses being reduced. Of note is the low level of bad debt, to which we owe thanks to the follow up of staff, members, and sponsors to ensure that revenues are collected in a timely fashion. Our accounting firm, Peace of Mind Bookkeeping has done an excellent job of keeping our books in order.

Our auditor commented on a successful financial performance, good governance, and excellent bookkeeping support. For this, I'd like to thank all of our members, partners, sponsors.

The CAFC has once again run a surplus of about \$167,984. While it is also our deliberate practice to be comprehensive in the budgeting of expenses and conservative in the anticipation of revenues, the substantial surplus in 2023 is due to the generous support of members, sponsors, grants and contract funding that came to the CAFC from organizations like Public Safety Canada, the Motorola Solutions Foundation, Transport Canada, CASA and others.

Surpluses in the not-for-profit world are interesting. On one hand they are a form of risk management. Consider that had the hurricane in Halifax at the beginning of FRC 2023 considering that each year our budget starts as zero, if all members, sponsors, and purveyors of grants, have the option of returning or not. We never take this for granted and will always work hard to earn your investment in the CAFC. On the other hand, we also have the obligation to invest surpluses in the best interests of our members. Over the coming year and certainly as the CAFC engages in its strategic plan renewal for 2025 to 2030, you will no doubt be presented with plans for this surplus.

I'd like to thank the Federal Departments and Foundations that entrust us with grants and contracts. I'd also like to thank staff, and our accounting and bookkeeping firm. Finally, I'd like to thank my fellow board members. Excellent financial performance is not a given for any association. Your diligence, discipline, care, cooperation, and wisdom make all the difference.

Finally, this is my last term as Treasurer and my last term on the Board as I retire from Leduc County Fire Department to new endeavours. I have been very blessed over the course of my 43 years in the fire service. I hope that we will continue to cross paths. It has truly been my pleasure serving you Treasurer and CAFC Board Member. Wishing good health, safety and prosperity.
