President's Report Fire Chief Ken McMullen

In my 25 years of experience with the CAFC, I have come to appreciate that each year seems to take on a flavour of its own at the national association. If I were to reflect on a theme for the past twelve months, I would choose the words of our third pillar, "messaging in service of safety".

This strategic pillar was set to recognize and leverage the ability, credibility, and necessity of the country's fire chiefs when it comes to delivering key messages in service of public health and safety. These messages include messaging to the public, to policy makers, to front line personnel, to community members and to the media.

Key to the effectiveness of this messaging is the work we do together to understand and substantiate the issues experienced nationally, determine solutions, and provide clear and credible advice.

To this effect, it was about 12 months ago now, that we began to see the results of the Great Canadian Fire Census, which for the first time included all types of fire departments in Canada. By December's Government Relations Week, the data had captured the imaginations of the media, and helped Canadian politicians and citizens alike appreciate the powerful and precarious nature of the fire sector.

Government relations week was our best yet with several meetings with Federal Ministers who not only understood the issues, but pledged their support, rose in the House for us and in some cases like the Cancer Framework Bill and funding for CIPSRT, acted on our advice. On the volunteer firefighter tax credit and Joint Emergency Preparedness Program, the advice was "don't give up" and "show us the data", which we're acting on.

Unfortunately, while most people like to be right, we were dismayed at how predictive our data and warnings were. By June we were in the midst of the worst wildfire season on record. The media took up the cause by storm landing us over 100 interviews nationally and across the world. Census 2023 is again confirming what we saw in 2022 and we will use every ounce of its power to solve the serious issues being experienced in our sector.

While the past year has put the strategic pillar of messaging in service of safety to the test and the face of the association in media sources around the country and globe, none of this would be possible without the work of the Board members, National Advisory Council and its Chair Chief Peter Krich, Staff and most especially the CAFC Committees and their Chairs.

In this annual report, you'll see what happens when a few dedicated individuals, or more accurately 150 individuals on 21 differ, decide to act. This annual report is dedicated to their efforts and the legacy they create. We thank each of them and every member of the association for your support. Associations are what members make of them. YOU make CAFC great.



Some Selected Highlights from the last 12 months...

Answer the Call	The Great Canadian Fire Census started at the Answer the Call Committee to answer the simple question: how many volunteer firefighters do we have. The Committee continues to champion an increase in the volunteer firefighter tax credit and has worked with MP Gord Johns on Bill C-264 now Bill C-310. It is currently launching the "Why I answer the call campaign" which will shine a light on Volunteer Firefighters which is a program designed to accept videos from volunteer firefighters.
Building Codes	Did you know that Canada has a new building codes process and that CAFC is a member of its national Advisory Council? The change in building codes process responds to many of the recommendations made by the CAFC Building Codes Committee over the years helping to level the playing field between industry and the fire service. The CAFC Building Codes committee also includes NRCAN staff, builders and members of the Wood Council. Finally, the committee is launching a model sprinkler bylaw for various provincial scenarios, chiefs notes for speaking to council and other
Cancer	One of the highlights of this year was the passing of Bill C-244 for a Firefighter Cancer Framework. Preceded by several testimonies before the House of Commons and Senate Standing Committees, discussions during GR week and collaboration with our friends at the IAFF, the bill reached unanimous agreement in both the Senate and the House of Commons.
Climate	Without knowing the type of Wildfire Season, we would have, the CAFC Climate Committee came up with a 13 point plan, supported by the CAFC's National Advisory Council, which summarizes what's needed for wildfire response. The plan became the basis of our conversations with the federal government, the Globe and Mail and media sources around the world. The Climate Committee also led two articles on the integration of Indigenous Wildfire Practices and the role of Fire Smart in Fire Departments.
Dangerous Goods	The Dangerous Goods Committee has worked with Transport Canada to set up a funding opportunity for fire departments to submit requests for funding that help close the gap in terms of zero emissions technologies. If you want to apply, you can find the funding opportunity on the CAFC website. It has taken on the hosting of the Canadian Emergency Response Flammable Liquids Incidents Training Program. It has provided representations in response to the review of the fireworks regulations.
Equity, Diversity and Inclusion	The Equity Diversity and Inclusion committee continues to explore the provision of free equity, diversity and inclusion training for fire departments and the front line staff within, hosts the equity, diversity and inclusion award, and is now beginning to look at issues like bullying in the fire service.
Executive Chief Fire Officer Council	The Council continues to expand the Executive Chief Fire Officer Program and the ECFO Aspire candidates. Excitingly this year, we have a record number of women chiefs achieving the ECFO designation. Thank you to all who continue to advance the importance of this designation.
Fire Prevention Committee	The Fire Prevention Committee is now working on the application and translation of the Quebec Fire Prevention Manual which it will make available shortly. It continues to advance the Fire Chiefs Ask Program, Emergency Preparedness Week, and Fire Prevention Week.
Governance	CAFC's First Governance committee has a draft report ready to help describe how fire sectors are governed across different countries and what factors may be considered in the proposal for a National Fire Advisor. The draft will be available for member comment in the fall and will serve as an anchor to help advance the national fire advisor ask that has been part of the CAFC's advocacy efforts.
Human Factors	The Human Factors committee has developed a curriculum and launched a call for instructors for its human factors course intended to provide any member with the skills and tools needed to apply human factor considerations to common fire sector scenarios. You can find the call for instructors on the website. Our hope is that the course will be available in 2024.



Some Selected Highlights from the last 12 months...

Interoperability	The Interoperability Committee has prepared a “what fire departments need to know” article for Canadian Fire Chief Magazine covering key items for consideration as they pertain to NG911, the PSBN, ever greening radio equipment etc. The Committee has also made representations to the Canadian Standards Association on the future of Intrinsically Safe Radios
Leadership	Responding to the idea that 25% of fire departments have deferred needed training including leadership development training as cited in the Great Canadian Fire Census 2022, the leadership committee has curated a course in leadership development and currently has a call out for instructors. We expect the course to be available in 2024.
Mental Health	The mental health committee continues to expand the number of trained trainers, who in turn offer free mental health awareness training to firefighters. Grants from the Motorola Solutions Foundation and Bell Let's Talk have helped us to make this possible. We're also looking at Fire Chiefs Mental Health and Psychological Safety and the impacts of bullying in the fire service and what can be done about it.
Remotely Piloted Aircraft	With thanks to a grant from Public Safety Canada and a partnership with the Canadian Air Search and Rescue Association, the Search and Rescue Volunteer Association of Canada and previously with the Canadian Emergency Response Robotics Association, has completed a second volume of the “Blue Book” which focuses on operating remotely piloted aircraft beyond visual line of site and is providing feedback on the regulatory consultation that will influence this form of operation into the future.
Resolutions & Nominations	The Resolutions and Nominations committee has led a successful call for resolutions and nominations, reviewed policies and made recommendations to the CAFC Board of Directors.



CAFC Financial Status and Treasurer's Report

On behalf of the CAFC Board of Directors and the Finance and Audit Committee, it is my pleasure to present the Treasurer's Report for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2021. You can find the audited financial statements on the CAFC website under About Us>Audited Financial Statements and Annual Reports and in your Annual General Meeting packages.

Looking at the statement of financial position, we see that the CAFC has a healthy balance of cash at 1.077M. Investments appear to have gone down from 2021. Accounts receivable have stayed consistent as have accounts payable and deferred revenue. This indicates that the CAFC has had some predictable expectations and arrangements. Net assets have increased because of the increase in membership, FRC revenues, grants and contracts. The CAFC has once again run a surplus of about 273,000 up from 240,000 the year before.

We see these details more clearly in the statement of income where consistent increases in membership revenues, the return of in person FRC and increased sponsorship and fundraising has assisted CAFC revenues. Despite the overall increase, CAFC's investments have incurred a significant loss. The CAFC Board of Directors will be meeting with our financial advisors to optimize our investment portfolio.

On the expense side, CAFC's payroll and conference expenses have increased with all other expenses being reduced. Of note is the low level of bad debt, to which we owe thanks to the follow up of staff, members and sponsors to ensure that revenues are collected in a timely fashion. Our accounting firm, Numetrica has done an excellent job of keeping our books in order.

We completed 2022 with a \$290,000 surplus. While it is also our deliberate practice to be comprehensive in the budgeting of expenses and conservative in the anticipation of revenues, the substantial surplus in 2021 is due to the generous support of members, sponsors, grants and contract funding that came to the CAFC from organizations like Public Safety Canada, the Motorola Solutions Foundation, Transport Canada, CASA and others.

Our auditor commented on a successful financial performance, good governance and excellent bookkeeping support. For this, I'd like to thank all of our members, partners, sponsors. I'd like to thank the Federal Departments and Foundations that entrust us with grants and contracts. I'd also like to thank staff, and our accounting and bookkeeping firm. Finally, I'd like to thank my fellow board members. Excellent financial performance is not a given for any association. Your diligence, discipline, care, cooperation and wisdom make all the difference.
