

CAL Leadership Institute (CALLI) FAQ's

1. What are the benefits of being a participant of the CALLI Leadership Institute?

CALLI is a wonderful place to grow your leadership skills, network with other participants throughout Colorado, and meet leaders in the Colorado Library community. Our goal is to provide you with tools and exposure necessary for future leadership roles within CAL and the Colorado Library Community.

2. What is the estimated cost for being involved in the CALLI program?

The registration fee is \$200, which includes all in person sessions. \$100 will be collected upon acceptance to the program, and the remaining \$100 will be due in January 2019. **Participants should factor in additional monetary commitments for the following:**

- The in person sessions will be held in the Denver-metro area. Some of the in-person sessions will span more than one day, so if you are outside of the metro area and will be traveling with a possible stay over in the Denver-metro area, plan on hotel, meals and mileage.
- Audio headset for webinars and online discussions.

3. What type of software will be used for the Online Webinars and Discussions?

We will use online meeting software as well as an online communication platform plan for our online sessions and discussions. Please plan on purchasing a USB headset before August 2018. If you would like to test your headset and computer configuration before our first session in August, feel free to contact a committee member.

4. What are the expectations of participants?

CALLI participants are expected to attend *all sessions* both in-person and online, participate in all class discussions, activities, exercises, required reading and assignments. The committee will make every effort to notify participants of well in advance the dates for all in person and online sessions. (See the Curriculum Overview for more details.)

5. What is the time commitment for CALLI?

In addition to the 5 in-person sessions and 7 online sessions, *participants should also plan on ten hours of work towards assignments and readings for each month during the program.*

Additionally, CALLI participants will be expected to serve on a CAL committee in any capacity for two years. Participants can start this commitment any time after starting the CALLI program.
