



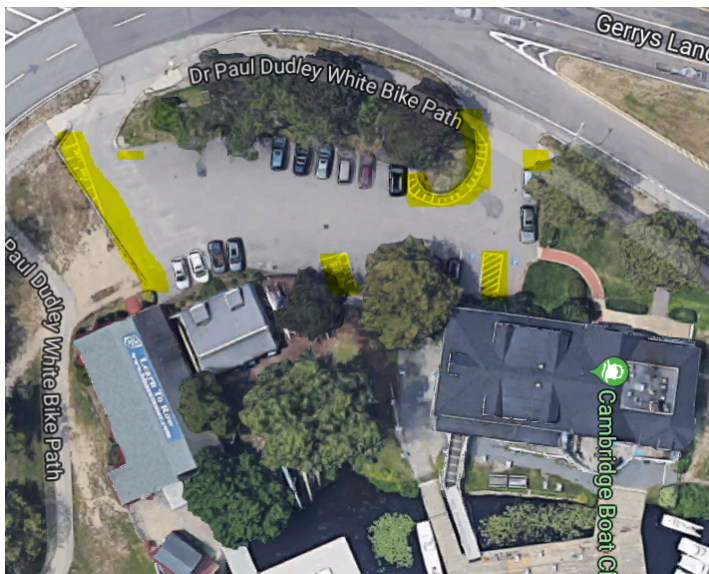
CBC Event Parking Guidelines

Parking at Cambridge Boat Club is very limited. We ask that renters and their guests please follow these rules and guidelines. To help alleviate parking issues, we do recommend that carpool, rideshare, or shuttle services be used whenever possible.

Parking anywhere is at your own risk.

CBC Lot (2 Gerrys Landing Rd, Cambridge)

- Cars should park as close together as possible.
- Do not park in the fire lanes (in front of our gate and along the BB&N side of the lot (see photo if you are not sure).
- There are two designated handicap parking spaces.
- If you park along the rose bush near the front door, pull forward enough that at least 2 cars can fit. Do not block the river path.
- Do not park in front of the door to the red building (BB&N's boathouse)
- Satellite map shows restricted areas in yellow.



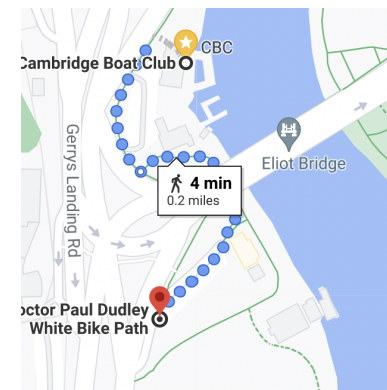
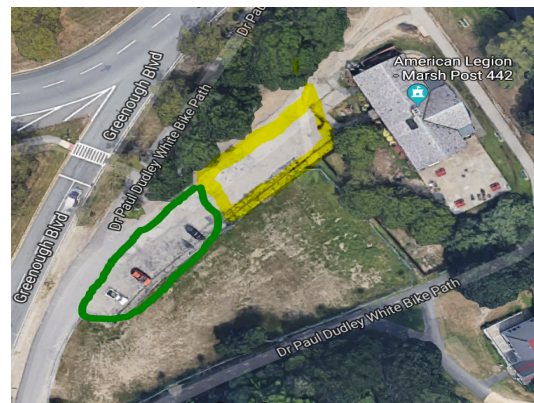


Alternative Parking Locations

There are a few nearby, free parking locations. Paid parking is also available in Harvard Square (about 1 mile from CBC) and along many side streets. *Parking is not guaranteed in any of the following locations.*

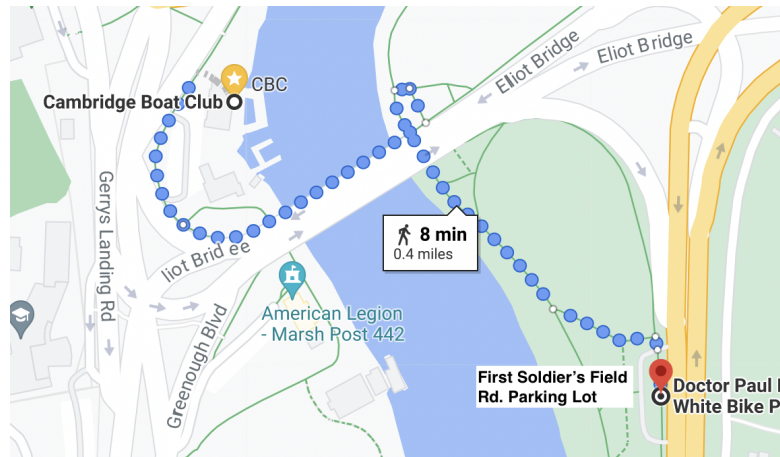
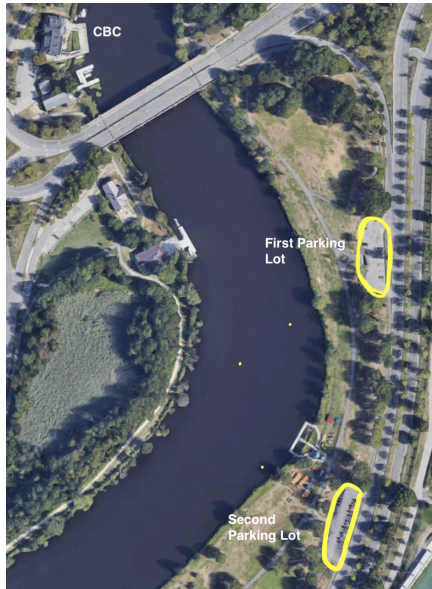
Marsh Post Lot (5 Greenough Blvd, Cambridge)

- The area in front of the Marsh Post fence is open for parking; marked in green on satellite map.
- The area inside the Marsh Post fence is not available for parking (marked in yellow on satellite map)
- Marsh Post is a 4 minute walk (0.2 miles) from CBC; you can reach CBC by following the sidewalk along the river and under the bridge. CBC is the grey building with blue shutters on the right, just past the bridge - see below at right.

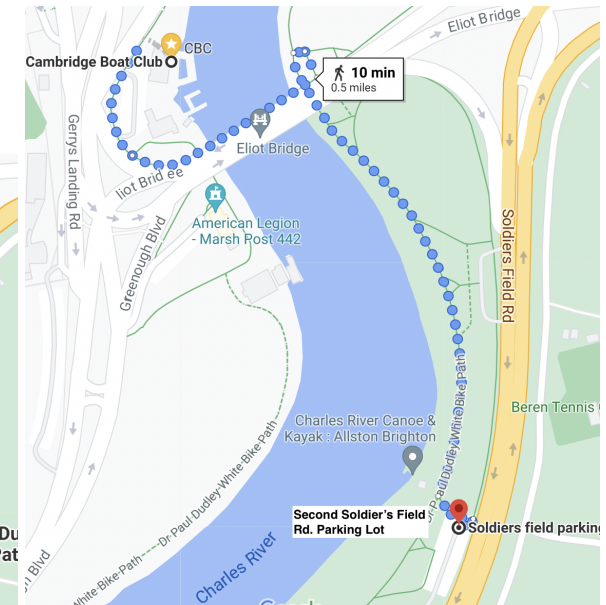


Christian Herter Park (Soldier's Field Rd, Allston)

- There are two public parking lots located on the opposite side of the Eliot bridge, on Soldier's Field Rd. circled in yellow at left.
- The first lot is located just over Eliot Bridge and is a 10 minute (0.5 miles) walk. To get to CBC, walk along the bike path toward the bridge; using the tunnel, cross under the bridge, turning right and heading up the stairs, continuing right to cross the bridge. Continue to follow the path to CBC (see below). The second lot is located 1/10th of a mile further down Soldier's Field Rd.

- You may not park on private property. This includes the small parking lot in front of BB&N's gym/fieldhouse and the one upstream.
- You may use non-restricted street parking.
