NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of applying for certification or re-certification by the CCCPA-CCCAP or CCCPLS-CCCSLP, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Undersigned agrees as follows:

1. Confidentiality. The Undersigned shall maintain in strict confidence, and will not disclose to any other party, any and all Confidential Information received by the Undersigned in connection with her or his application for certification or re-certification by the CCCPA-CCCAP or CCCPLS-CCCSLP. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Undersigned acknowledges and agrees that he or she will not discuss or disclose examination content with others (except CCCPA-CCCAP/CCCPLS-CCCSLP personnel) at any time, in any form during or after an examination. This includes comparing responses with others, sharing examination content with future examination candidates, and posting case information or examination questions online.

2. Disciplinary Measures. The Undersigned acknowledges and agrees that any breach of the confidentiality obligations in this Agreement may lead to disciplinary measures, including the invalidation of the Undersigned's exam results and a rejection of her or his application as well as prevention of her or his participation in future examinations. The Undersigned further acknowledges and agrees not to participate in any fraudulent exam-taking processes.

3. Definition. "Confidential Information" as used in this Agreement, means all information and materials that are disclosed, or otherwise provided, or made available, to the Undersigned in connection with her or his application for certification or re-certification by the CCCPA-CCCAP or CCCPLS-CCCSLP, except such information and materials as are available on the CCCPA-CCCAP/CCCPLS-CCCSLP website.
