Registered Environmental Practitioner

Registered Environmental Practitioner (REnvP) is the professional title for environmental Practitioners. Registered Environmental Practitioners come from a broad range of professions across industry, government, education, and the public sector. They all have demonstrated a level of knowledge, understanding and skills to protect and enhance the environment in a sustainable way.

Before you apply

In order to apply to become a Registered Environmental Practitioner you must hold CABE membership. You must also have a level of knowledge, understanding and skills equivalent to at least Level 5 in the Qualifications and Credit Framework of England Wales and Northern Ireland (2013) and at least the equivalent of three years' full-time relevant work-based practice.

Use this form to apply to become a Registered Environmental Practitioner with the Society for the Environment.

Application process

Step 1

Complete and submit this form along with the required supporting documents – this is then reviewed by the CABE Professional Review Team and if successful you will be invited to proceed to step 2.

Step 2

Complete and submit the Competency Review – this will then be assessed by two registered, trained assessors. You will either be successful at this stage and proceed to registration or you could be invited to an interview to obtain some additional evidence. If an interview* is required, this will be conducted remotely using online software and scheduled with you accordingly. If however, you are unsuccessful at any stage you will be provided with feedback regarding your application.

*An Interview is charged as an additional fee, as detailed in Section 3.


