The Exam will be proctored by IAEM-USA Treasurer Hugh Daniels, CEM. In order to sit for the exam individuals must have already submitted an application for AEM® or CEM® and paid the submission processing and examination fee. Visit www.iaem.com/certification and go to the Initial Certification page for the current rates. Qualified candidates (application submitted and fee paid) are required to take a 100-question multiple-choice examination and pass by 75% in order to receive the AEM®/CEM® designation. ***The deadline for registering through the IAEM website for the proctored exam will be October 7th due to IAEM's requirement to confirm eligibility and mail exams.
