### RFI #1

Question: Can you please provide FTE counts as we need to quote correct level.

EES has 4 price levels and each level is based on faculty/staff Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) employees in the participating Institution.

Level A: 1000-2999 FTE

Level B: 3000-9999 FTE

Level C: 10000-24999 FTE

Level D: 25000 & above FTE

Answer: King County Office of Education has 302 FTE.

### RFI #2

Question: Part numbers provided by you are from MS EES but to be eligible to purchase via EES you must have minimum 1000 FTE counts for Level A

Can you please provide quantities for each Ln Item.

Answer: The "or equivalent" is intended to allow bidders to propose pricing for any Microsoft volume licensing program. KCOE's Knowledge Worker count exceeds 25. To the extent you have discounts based on number ordered, please state those discounts in your proposal.

### RFI #3
