



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. How does one become a member of the Hall of Fame?
 - a. Inductees must have won the Lifetime Achievement award and must be approved by the sitting Board of Directors.
2. If the awards program just started, how did those being shown on the website get inducted?
 - a. In 2019, several members were inducted by the current Board of Directors based on their past service. These individuals are all past board members and served for several years, first as volunteers, then as board members. They were all part of the organization before any staff were hired, and therefore we responsible for the day-to-day operations and for the success of the annual conference. Most have already retired but some are still contributing to the K-12 community and to CETPA. The current board wanted to be sure their dedication was noticed.
