

## Executive Director Search

The Commissioned Officers Association of the U.S. Public Health Service (COA), located in the Washington, DC suburb of Landover, MD, is conducting a search for their next Executive Director. The mission of COA is to protect and enhance the public health and safety of the United States by supporting and advancing the interests of the Commissioned Corps of the U.S. Public Health Service. COA also has a foundation, the USPHS Commissioned Officers Foundation for the Advancement of Public Health (COF).

USPHS is one of seven uniformed services including the: USPHS, Navy, Army, Air Force, Coast Guard, Marine Corps and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA). For more than 200 years, men and women of the USPHS have served on the front lines of the nation's public health.

The combined COA/COF enterprise employs a staff of 6 FTEs and has a combined enterprise budget of approximately \$1.8M. COA revenues are derived primarily from membership dues, investment income, and group insurance royalties. COF revenues are principally from the annual symposium, grants, and donations.

The Executive Director is responsible equally to both the COA and COF Boards for the executive leadership, management, and direction of the combined enterprise. Under the supervision of the Executive Committees, the Executive Director's responsibilities include the strategic oversight and administration of the enterprise headquarters office and the two organizations. The Executive Director will plan, formulate and recommend the policies and programs which will further the objectives of the organization.
