Captain Jessica Feda has been assigned to the Bureau of Prisons (BOP) since 2005 and currently serves as the Chief of Rehabilitation Services where she oversees the provision of therapy services to greater than 700 inmates across four disciplines. As a physical therapist, CAPT Feda provides comprehensive evaluation and treatment services for inmates with orthopedic, neurologic and wound care rehabilitative needs.

CAPT Feda has served as a Commissioned Officer Association (COA) Board of Directors member since July 2015. CAPT Feda has served as the Chair of the Constitution and Resolution Committee and is currently serving as the Vice-Chair of the Local Branch Committee. During the 2015-2016 term, CAPT Feda along with the support of COA and her strong committee membership has increased committee participation 600%, completed a large-scale branch verification project, initiated
