CAPT Paul Jung is an officer in the Commissioned Corps of the U.S. Public Health Service. CAPT Jung has held assignments at the Health Resources and Services Administration, Indian Health Service, Peace Corps, Office of the Surgeon General, Centers for Disease Control, National Institutes of Health, and Food and Drug Administration. CAPT Jung chaired the Physicians Professional Advisory Committee of the U.S. Public Health Service for two terms. He graduated from the University of Maryland School of Medicine, completed residencies in internal medicine at Case Western Reserve University and preventive medicine at Emory University, and earned his M.P.H. as a Robert Wood Johnson Clinical Scholar at Johns Hopkins University.
