SUBJECT: Franklinton Emergency Department Closure

Mount Carmel's Franklinton Emergency Department at 120 S. Green Street will permanently close on **August 22, 2026**.

On August 24, 2026, Mount Carmel will open the new Mount Carmel Franklinton Care Center in the Fortuity Building. The care center will provide primary care, preventative and whole-person health services, including same-day and walk-in appointments, women's health services, behavioral health support, and connections to community resources. **The care center will not provide emergency department services.**

This change reflects the community's growing need for convenient, same-day primary care and coordinated support. Mount Carmel remains committed to serving the Franklinton community and will continue to invest in services and programs that support the health and well-being of our neighbors.

The Emergency Department will end service on August 22, 2026. To help you prepare for this transition, please note the following timeline:

- On **August 21, 2026, at 8:00 a.m.**, the Franklinton Emergency Department will stop accepting EMS traffic except for patients with urgent or immediate care needs.
- On **August 22 at 12:00 p.m.**, The Emergency Department will stop accepting walk-in patients.
- On **August 22 at 3:00 p.m.**, The Franklinton Emergency Department will close permanently and will no longer accept EMS transport or walk-in patients.

Please update transport plans as needed to reflect these changes. We appreciate your partnership and your continued service to the community as Mount Carmel transitions care at the Franklinton campus.
