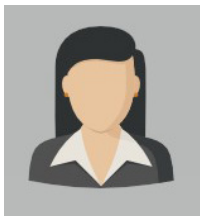

SANDRA RUBINO, PROJECT MANAGER

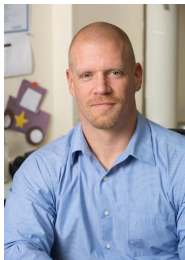
