General Guidelines and Instructions

Selection Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated on academic achievement, demonstrated leadership skills and extracurricular activities. Application must be typed or legibly hand written and completed in its entirety. If space is limited, additional pages may be used. Please include the Question you are responding to on any additional paper used. Pages that are added and not 'labeled' may be overlooked as pertinent content and not considered during evaluation.

Applicant Status

All applicants must have a biological or legal adoptive parent who is a member in good standing of the CPPA, or be a member in good standing of the CPPA. (Except for applicants who are applying for Killed in the Line of Duty). Member profile must be up to date and accurate. In addition, applicant must be a graduating High School Senior or a Current Student in higher education.

Accountability

Applicants must complete at least one semester or one quarter as a full-time student within one calendar year of receipt of a scholarship award. **Failure to make this progress and follow-up report will make the applicant liable for a full repayment of the award within the same calendar year and will further disqualify applicant for any future scholarship consideration. Transcripts shall be mailed to the CPPA no later than August 31ST of the following year.**

Other

This award is not based on financial need. Receipt of additional scholarships from other organizations will not disqualify a candidate from consideration. This award shall be made in one payment to be used by the applicant.

Information Needed

- Official high school transcripts of student's grades from 9th grade to date of application for this scholarship
- If applicant is already enrolled in college, transcripts must include all college work to date. Transcripts must bear an original signature and seal of the proper school authority.
- SAT and ACT test scores must be included but may be a photocopy of the original, if not listed on transcripts.
- **A Letter of Recommendation, from one person in authority from the high school or college currently attended by the applicant is required. Additional 'Character' Letters of Recommendation by co-workers, classmates, friends, neighbors, etc (anyone, other than family, with the insight to your character) will also be considered. Letters must be current, notate relationship, be dated and signed.**
- Copies of exhibits of achievement in scholarship, leadership, athletics, dramatics, community service or other activities may be attached.
- Applicant's personal biography (maximum one page)
- Applicant's photo (maximum size 5x7)
