Student Instructions and Materials

Instructions:

1. This material is only for those planning to take the exam for credit. No auditors are allowed. If you have not signed up to take this course for credit, please excuse yourself.
2. If you have questions about your eligibility to take this class, verify with your instructor that you meet the requirements to become a junior judge.
3. Record your registration number (this is the number beside your name on the sign-in sheet for the class) on the enclosed Application for Junior Exhibition Judge form, and on the Point-Scoring Exam sheets.
4. Read, complete and sign the Application for Junior Exhibition Judge.
5. Use your handbook, *DAYLILY EXHIBITIONS: a practical handbook for daylily exhibitors, judges and show chairs*, especially Figures 9, 10 and the seedling distinction checklist, plus your Practice Point-Scoring sheets during the written examination.
6. Upon completing the Point-Scoring Examination:
 - a. Review your exam carefully and leave NO COMMENT BOX BLANK (3 point deduction)
 - b. Re-verify your addition (2 point deduction)
 - c. Complete the clinic evaluation form
7. Turn in your exam, application and evaluation form to your instructor at the conclusion of the exam.
8. Retain the practice point-scoring sheet for future reference.
9. When you have completed all senior judge requirements (see the senior judge application form on the AHS Portal), as noted in *DAYLILY EXHIBITIONS*, download the application, fill in and send to the AHS Exhibition Judges' Chair.

NOTE: You will become a junior exhibition Judge, and be eligible to judge ONLY when you've received certification that you have passed the graded point scoring exam with a passing score of at least 70.

Due to seasonal pressure, notification of your exam status may take from one to two months. Please be patient.
