## **Keynote Presentation**

### **Concussion Lecture**

This presentation will discuss utilization of vestibular exams and will allow you to use proper screening for concussion and to initiate prompt brain rest and referral to a concussion specialist. Dr. Schuller will discuss how to utilize neurocognitive testing for diagnosing, location, and degrees of concussion. He will also discuss how to utilize the latest UPMC ( University of Pittsburg Medical Center) protocols for treatment following recovery for return to play, academics, work, and life activities.

## **Adult Track**

### **Cognitive Evaluation**

This session covers the importance of cognitive assessments, functional vs standardized assessments, types of specific assessments, and how to utilize outcomes of assessments to direct treatment.

### **Role of OT in Adult Concussion Treatment**

This session covers the mechanism of injury, presentation of symptoms and areas of impairments noted in adults who have sustained a concussion. The facets of a comprehensive OT evaluation will be reviewed as well as how to utilize the assessment results to direct the course of care. Therapist will learn and understand OT's unique role in concussion management.

## **Pediatric Track**

### **Occupation Therapy's Role in Pediatric Concussion: Evaluation and Treatment**

This course will help therapist gain a general understanding of concussion and those areas that need to be addressed in an Occupational Therapy evaluation. Therapist will learn components of vision impacted by concussion and how to treat them. You will learn how to recognize and treat cognitive impairments seen in concussion patients. Therapist will learn how to treat to address return to school and sport, utilize task analysis skills, and how to support parents to advocate for their child with a concussion to support successful re entry into their academic curriculum.

### **NBCOT**

This course will educate attendees on the NBCOT Navigator an online continuing competency tool
