



COVID Education Innovation in Florida

Parent Academy (Duval County)

Not all parents have the same skill level to assist their children during at-home learning and when classrooms went completely online and students struggled, parents began looking for support from Duval County Public Schools.

The District Family and Community Engagement (FACE) Office and teachers, through a partnership with the Parent Academy, worked with St. Stephen Church to set-up a Zoom platform to answer parent questions in the evenings. Parents were greeted in a main channel and then sent to a break-out room by content area for support. Parents and caregivers have become acclimated to visiting the site for homework help and the online platform gives them real-time access without having to leave their homes, which makes it less intimidating to ask for help.

The result of this initiative is that parents and students are learning together, spending quality time together, and truly engaged in standards-based tasks. Parents have a better idea of grade-level requirements since they have been tasked with providing support in the at-home environment. It has spilled over into other areas, as well. For example, the FACE Office offered a Parent Academy workshop on Implicit Bias advertised through these channels and had the best participation of any FACE parent workshop.
