1. Preparation of an orientation guide
2. University-wide discourse on ethical considerations of our international cooperations, involvement of the Senate Ethics Committee

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3. Implementation of an institutional routine: Engagement with the political framework and the cultural and religious characteristics of the partner country
4. Drawing up a list of questions on possible problematic consequences of cooperation as a guideline for project managers and other participants
5. Creation of a crisis management protocol as a "script" in the case of a concrete crisis event
