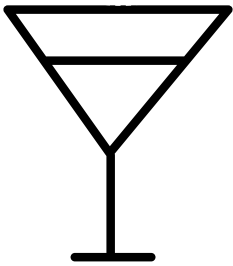
Our Event

Benefits include: visibility and recognition on-site, acknowledgement in the event program book and marketing, and opportunity to connect with a 55-year-old fellowship.

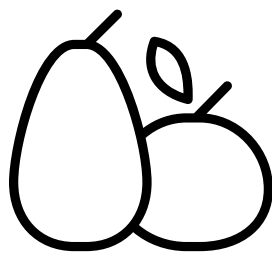
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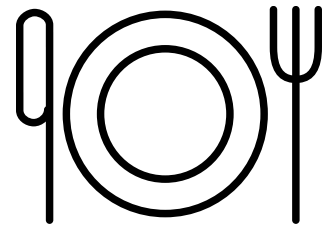
