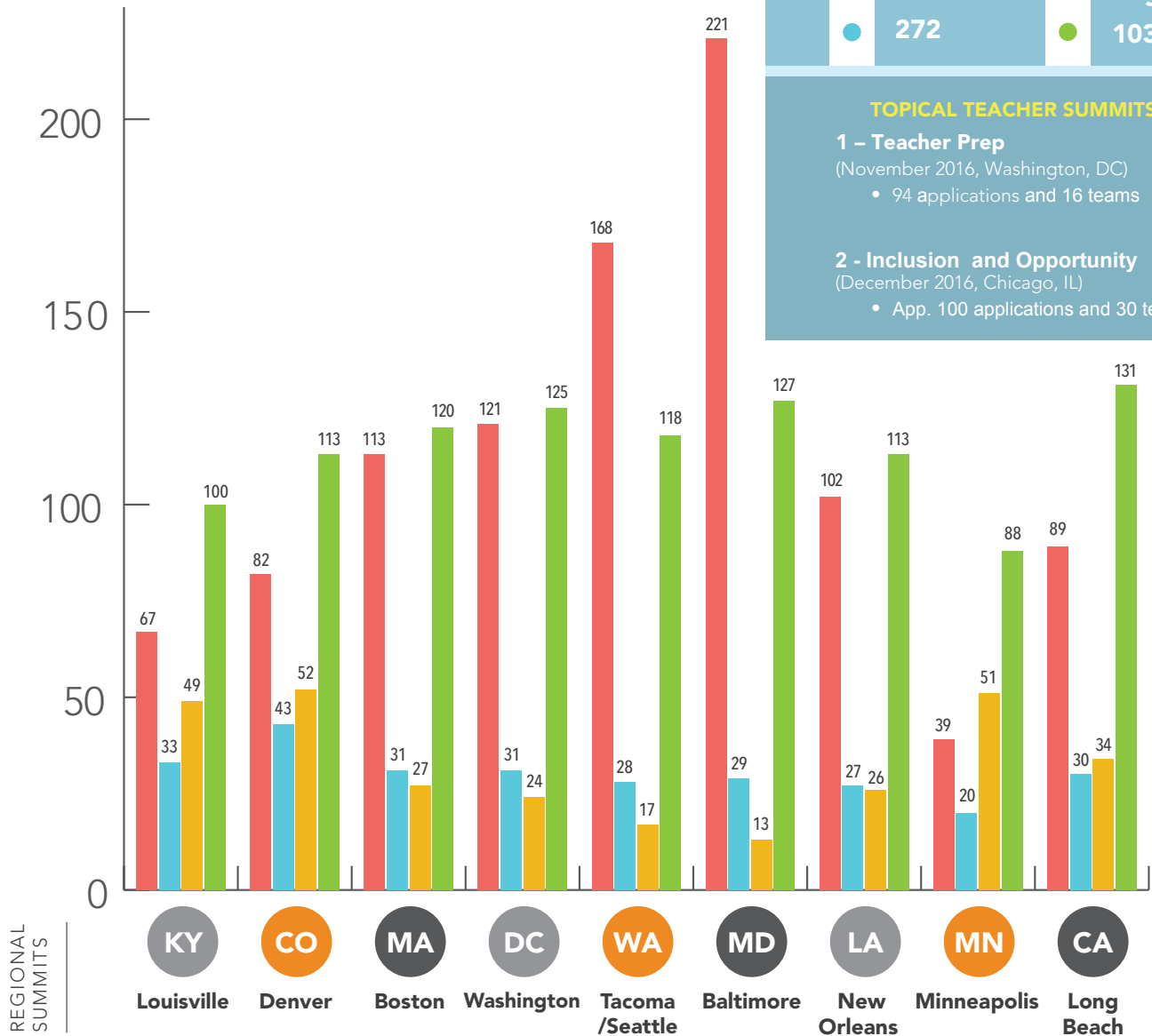

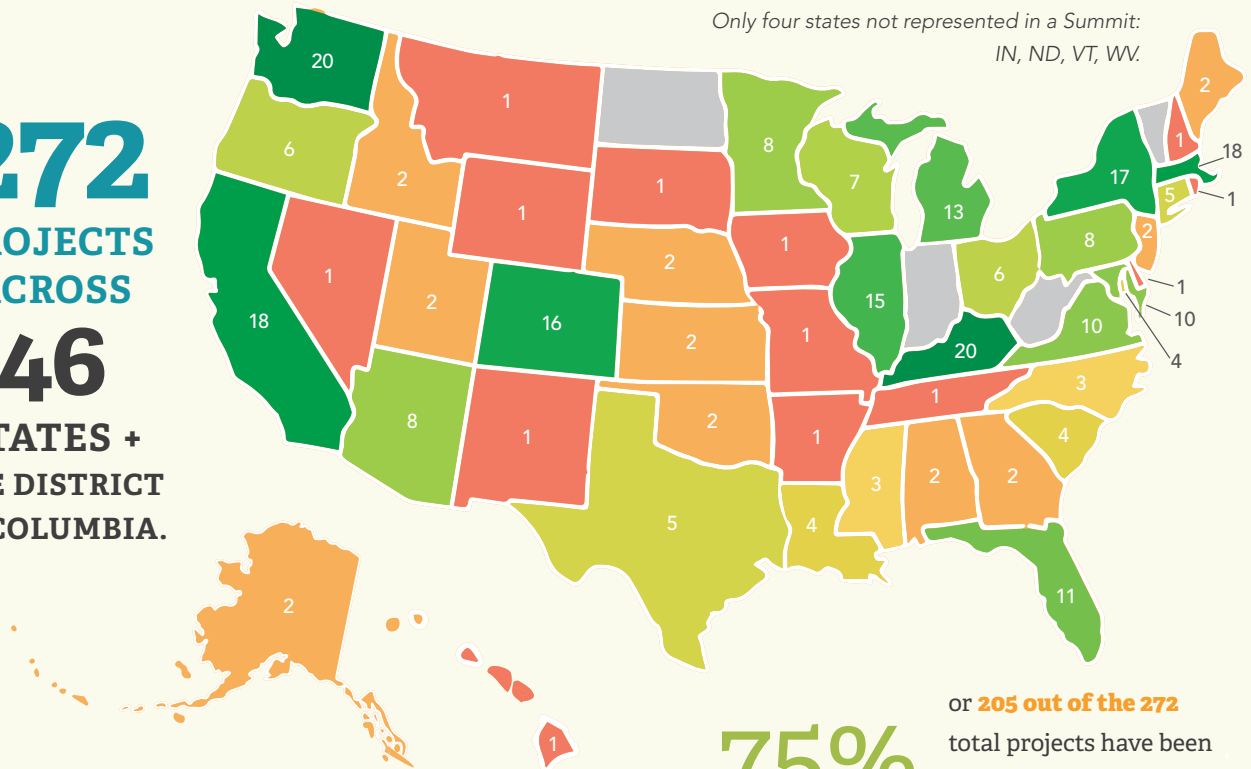
REGIONAL SUMMITS
