



Christoph BROCHHAUSEN, MD, Full Professor

Christoph Brochhausen is the Vice Chair of Pathology at the University of Regensburg and leads the Tissue Biobank at the Comprehensive Cancer Center East Bavaria as well as the Central Biobank Regensburg, Germany.

He is co-chair of the ESBB-Working group "Regulatory, Ethics & GDPR. As senior consultant pathologist he is responsible for the diagnostic service of the electron microscopy unit. He is specialised in orthopaedic-, respiratory- and cardio-vascular pathology.

His research is focused on Digital Pathology, Cryotechnology, Tissue Engineering and Regenerative Medicine. Christoph Brochhausen coordinats BRoTHER, a Bavarian-Czech research project in biobank cooperation. He is awarded with the Michalis lecture, Trinity College Cambridge (UK, 2008), the Best Paper Award of the European Society of Biomaterials (2009), the "Land of Ideas" award from the German Government (2012), the Histalim biotechnology award (France, 2015) and the "Ars legendi award" of the German Medical Faculty Day (2015).
