FBI-LEEDA College Scholarship

Each year, the FBI-LEEDA scholarship program offers five \$1,000 scholarships to college-bound high school students. This year's scholarships will be awarded at the 29th Annual Executive Education Conference April 27th-29th in Kansas City, Missouri.

Eligibility

You must be enrolled or be accepted by an undergraduate program at the time you submit the application. You must maintain a 3.0 cumulative grade point average for three years to be eligible to submit an application. You must have graduated from high school prior to disbursement of funds. You do not have to be related or have a relationship with an FBI-LEEDA member to be considered.

Provisions

An individual may receive only one scholarship award of \$1,000 per year from FBI-LEEDA. FBI-LEEDA will make the scholarship award payment to the recipients school on or before August 1. An applicant may re-apply each year providing eligibility requirements are fulfilled.

Basics

Applications for the 2020-2021 academic school year are now being accepted. Your application must be postmarked by **March 27, 2020** to be considered. FBI-LEEDA selects final candidates based on the following criteria:
