You must complete the Trainee Awareness Through Movement Teacher authorization form and submit it to FGNA before you are authorized to use FGNA service marks Feldenkrais®, Awareness Through Movement®, and ATM®, to identify your teaching and promote yourself as an Authorized Trainee ATM teacher: https://www.feldenkraisguild.com/trainee-atm-auth.
