The unique 17-acre Historic Fourth Ward Park transformed a barren, contaminated site north of Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthplace into a vision for sustainable development. Flood protection and storm water overflow solutions are disguised as a park. In addition, the Eastside Trail transformed a 2.25 mile long abandoned heavy freight rail corridor into a public recreation oasis.
