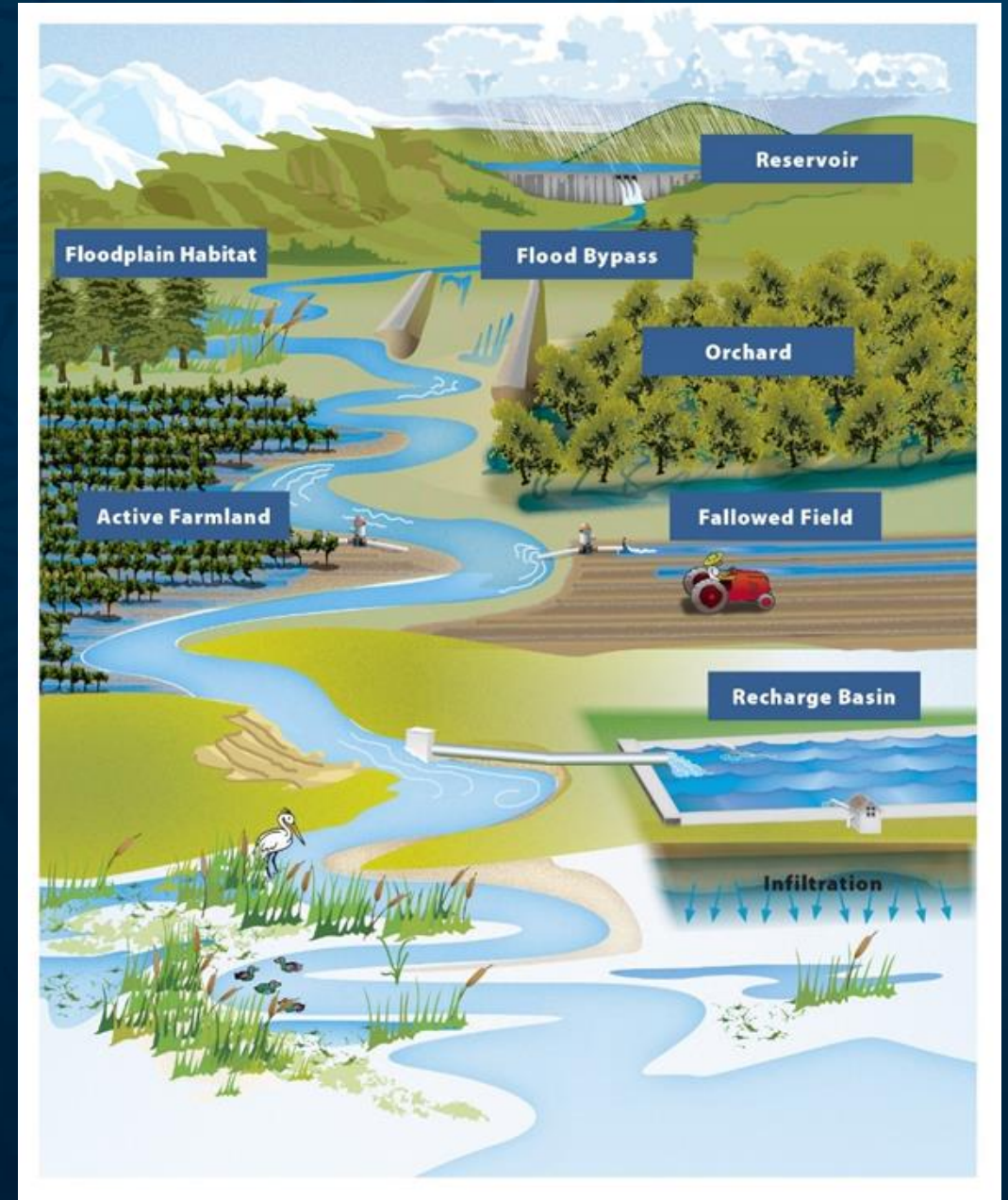

What is Flood-MAR?

Using high flows from, or in anticipation of, rainfall or snowmelt, for managed aquifer recharge on agricultural lands, working landscapes, and natural managed lands

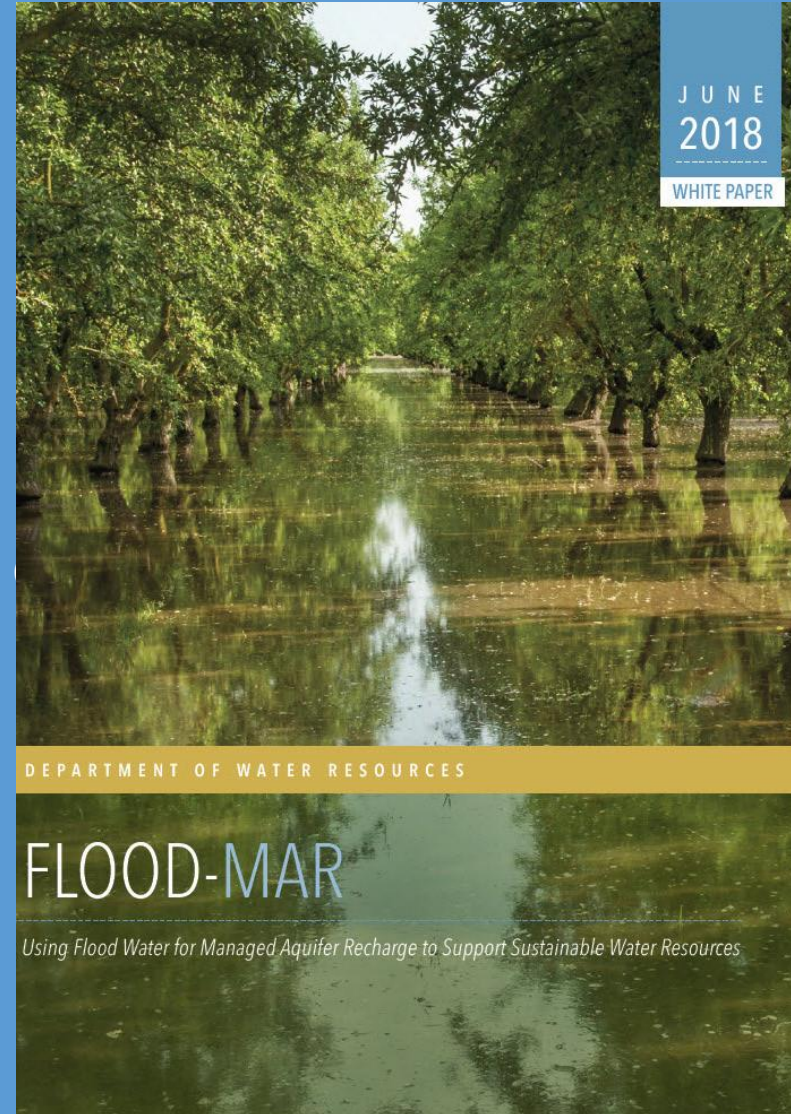


Public Benefits of Flood-MAR
